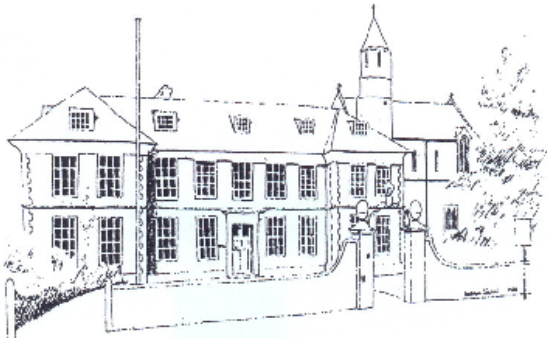
Any drop in the number of delegates from

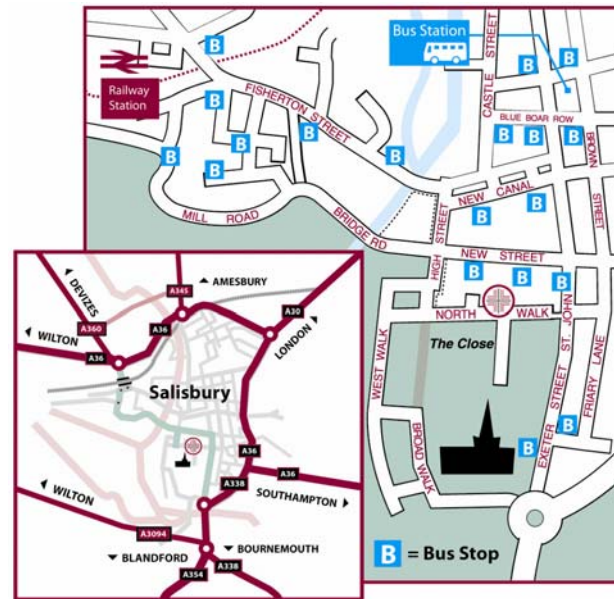

Salisbury is a historical market town ideally situated in a region with heritage sites dating from 5,000 years ago. The College is a five-minute walk to the High Street with cafes, shops, theatre and cinema; bus and rail stations are a 15-minute walk away.

## How To Find Us



Public transport is the best way to travel to Sarum College.

### **Arrival by bus or train**

The College is approximately a 15-minute walk from either station.

### **Park and Ride**

There are four drop-off sites:

From the North: A345 (Beehive Roundabout)

From the South: A338 at Britford

From the East: A30 London Road

From the West: A36 At Wilton.

The connecting bus stops within a 10-minute walk of Sarum.
