FEES AND METHODS OF PAYMENT **2011/2012 Academic Year**

When accepting an offer of a place on an MA programme, you will be asked to pay a non-refundable registration fee of £100 to secure your place.

The fee for each of the three years of either of the MA programmes for students starting in 2011 is £1850 (£2700 for non-EU students), so the total fee for 3 years excluding registration fee is £5550 (£8100 for non-EU students).

(Please note that the MA in Christian Approaches to Leadership has an added fee of £100 for the personality questionnaire exercise during the first Core Module, which is to be paid before the start of that module.)

The fee for extending the period of study beyond the three year period of study is currently £500 per year (see Extension of Study Period below).

Fees are due at the beginning of September of each year. You can pay in full, which attracts a £150 discount if paid before 1 September 2011, or spread the payment of fees over the 3 years. If a student withdraws during the year, the fees due will be either the cost of the number of individual modules/dissertation started or the cost of number of academic years started, whichever is the greater.

The fees include classes, supervision, assessment, administration and use of the library.

The fee does not include meals or accommodation, for which a separate charge is made in advance of any module and payable two weeks before the start of the module. Modules can be taken on a residential or non-residential basis and the current package prices are £147/£190/£240 and £42 respectively (dependent on the class of the room). The College regrets that it cannot refund meals or accommodation not taken up. Note: all fees and prices will be reviewed at the beginning of July each year.

You may pay the fees for the programme by one of the following three methods:

1. **By one lump sum of £5550*** (£8100 for non-EU students).

If the whole fee for the programme is paid before 1 September 2011, there is a discount of £150 i.e. £5400.

Please make your payment payable to '**Sarum College**'.

*£5650 EU/£8200 overseas for the MA in Christian Approaches to Leadership. If paid prior to 1 September 2011: £5500 EU/£8,050.

2. **Six instalments of £925** (£1350 for non-EU students).

The instalments are payable:

1 September 2011, 1 March 2012, 1 September 2012, 1 March 2013, 1 September 2013, 1 March 2014.

(Please note that the MA in Christian Approaches to Leadership has an added fee of £100 for the personality questionnaire exercise during the first Core Module, which is to be paid before the start of that module.)

3. **Three annual instalments of £1850** (£2700 for non-EU students).

The instalments are payable:

1 September 2011, 1 September 2012, 1 September 2013.

(Please note that the MA in Christian Approaches to Leadership has an added fee of £100 for the personality questionnaire exercise during the first Core Module, which is to be paid before the start of that module.)

Withdrawal from study

If you withdraw from the course, you will be charged the full year fees for the number of years of study that you have commenced, plus any additional modules over and above 3 modules in year one, 6 modules in year two and 6 modules and the dissertation in year three. The date of withdrawal will be the date of receipt of a formal notification of withdrawal by the validating university.

Extension of period of study

The fees are calculated on the following basis:

Postgraduate Certificate - completed within 1 year of starting the course.

Postgraduate Diploma - completed within 2 years of starting the course.

Masters Degree - completed within 3 years of starting the course.

If you wish to extend your period of study beyond these periods there will be a charge of £500 per year of extension and will apply as follows :

Postgraduate Certificate – extension beyond 1 June 2013

Postgraduate Diploma – extension beyond 1 June 2014

Masters Degree – extension beyond 31 July 2015

Permission to extend modules and the dissertation must be applied for and granted by the Programme Committee.

Audit Fees

Students may attend modules in addition to those which they are studying for credit, by permission of the Programme Leader. The hospitality rates will be the usual student rates of £147/£190/£240 and £42 respectively (dependent on the class of the room), with an added administration fee of £20 per booking. Please note that students must give clear information on whether they are attending modules as part of their accredited study in advance of attendance. Should the module be oversubscribed, preference will be given to students taking the module for credit.

Note: all fees and prices will be reviewed at the beginning of July each year.
